An emerging threat to adult brains in rural India

With changing socioeconomic status the disease pattern is changing rapidly among adults in rural India. Our community-based studies in rural Gadchiroli, Maharashtra have shown that stroke has emerged as an important public health problem with significant mortality and morbidity. Can the risk of stroke be mitigated in rural India? We are testing the effectiveness of a community-based programme for reducing the risk of stroke in a cluster randomised controlled trial in a population of 70,000 in rural Gadchiroli.
