- 38.GST rule will be applicable with effect from 01.07.2017. The applicable TDS /other charges if any as per GST rule will be deducted as per new GST regime.
- 39. TIFR-Hyderabad GST NO: 36AAATT3951F2ZG.
- 40. The contractor should provide mobile telephone on site for communicating 24 x 7 basis duty personnel.
- 41. The contractor shall pay the minimum monthly wages (Central) fixed by the Chief Labour Commissioner (Central), Delhi, Govt. of India, Ministry of Labour & Employment under the Minimum Wages Act as applicable in Hyderabad.
- 42. Enhancement in Administrative/Service charges, on any ground will not be entertained during the tenure of the contract.
- 43. The contract can be terminated on any of the following contingencies:
 - a) On expiry of the contract period.
 - b) By giving one month advance notice by TIFR on account of:
 - i) Un Satisfactory performance of the contract (as per tender terms and conditions).
 - ii) Losses suffered by TIFR due to lapse on the part of the contractor/his Supervisor/workers.
 - iii) For committing breach by the contractor of any of the terms and conditions of Contract.
 - iv) On assigning the contractor or any part thereof or any benefit or interest therein or there under by the contractor to any third person for sub-contracting whole or part of the contract.

- 44. During the notice period of termination of the contract in the contingencies contemplated above, the contractor shall keep on discharging his duties as before till the expiry of notice period.
- 45.It shall be the duty of the contractor to withdraw all the persons deployed by him on expiry/termination of the contract and will ensure that no person creates any disruption/hindrance or problems of whatsoever nature to TIFR.
- 46. Income Tax will be recovered from the contractor's monthly bill as per the Govt. of India's order and necessary TDS certificate will be issued to him as a proof of having deducted the tax.
- 47. All disputes arising from this contract in respect of personnel posted at TIFR concerning their wages or any other matter connected with their service conditions under relevant Labour Laws are solely and wholly the responsibility of the Contractor. The TIFR will be free from all encumbrances either from the Government or from any other sources.

In the event of such arbitrator to whom the matter is originally referred is being transferred or vacating his office or resigning or refusing to work or neglecting his work or being unable to act for any reason whatsoever, the TIFR shall appoint another person to act as arbitrator in place of the outgoing arbitrator in accordance with the terms of this agreement and the persons so appointed shall be entitled to proceed with the reference from the stage at which it was left by his predecessor.
- C) The Arbitrator may give interim award(s) and/or directions, as may be required.
- D) Subject to the aforesaid provisions, the Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996 and the rules made hereunder and any modifications are there of from time to time being in force shall be deemed to apply to the arbitration proceedings under this clause.

iv. Free replacement of washers, Teflon tape, white cement/OPC for minor maintenance works and other individual items costing less than Rs. 100/-.

v. Replacement of gaskets, buffers, rings, springs, white zinc and spun yarn for servicing the water closets & seats, flush valves, urinals, non-return valves, ball cocks, health faucets and fittings etc costing more than Rs. 100/- will be reimbursed on actual on production of bills.

2. Maintenance & Cleaning:

- i. Besides the above routine works, the scope of work shall include arresting leakages in the water supply and sanitary lines by using zinc and spun yarn/cement, removal of chokes from water closets, urinals, wash basins, sinks, floor traps, soil and waste pipes, rain water pipes, porcelain traps and underground drain lines and water lines inside the compound. 1.Contractor shall attend to all the works 24x7 and post One Skilled worker (Assistant Plumber cum Fitter cum Mechanic) in 3 Shifts (ie. from 6:00 am to 2:00 pm, 2:00 pm to 10:00 pm and 10:00 pm to 6:00 am) and One Highly Skilled Supervisor (Head Plumber cum Mechanic cum Fitter) in Regular Shift (i.e. from 9:00am to 5:00pm) all days during the entire contract period for maintenance of Water Supply, Sewerage, Sanitation, Plumbing including servicing of Sanitary fittings & fixtures, Rain water harvesting system and Fire fighting installations.

4. Replacement of Spares:

Cost of individual spares ie. more than Rs. 100/- such as bottle trap, flush valve, seat cover, bib tap etc. required for replacement/maintenance of the plumbing/sanitary items, shall be borne by TIFR-Hyderabad. Any other items ie. washer. Nuts, Bolts, Clamps, etc. costing less than Rs. 100/- shall be borne by the contractor and no extra payment will be made.

- 5. Plumbers & helpers should have proper uniform with continuous display of Identity Card. Each plumber shall be provided with a tool bag containing all the necessary tools.
- 6. Arrange visit of plumbing engineer once in a quarter for inspection and submit report to TIFR-Hyderabad's Engineer about his observations. He should also visit whenever major repairs of existing pipelines are involved in Tower. Details regarding Plumbing Engineer ie. Name, Qualification, Experience shall be given at the time of submission of tender.
- 7. The contractor is required to maintain following registers during the job of AMC:
 - i) Daily pump operation register
 - ii) Daily water tank filling register
 - iii) Daily checking of toilets attending the faults/complaints
 - iv) Checklist as per scope of work

- 8. Filling the joints of traps and cracks/joints/holes of walls, ceilings, kitchen sink/platform, wash basins, bathrooms, toilets, side of door frames, sills etc. with suitable sealant, adhesives, cement etc. and pointing of tiles at no extra cost for area less than 100 Sft on any single time.
- 9. Charges for Scaffolding, Centering, Shuttering, Cradle (Jhula) and Curing will not be paid extra for any works related to maintenance/repair/replacement.
- 10. Contractor shall follow the prescribed formats/procedures for receiving complaints, receiving the work slips duly sanctioned and preparation of bills etc. as stipulated by TIFR-Hyderabad from time to time.
- 11. Contractor shall maintain a proper record/register indicating reasons for not attending to any particular complaint within time schedule, failing which penalty shall be levied.

- Pumping of domestic water to all terrace tanks. Maintaining records of water pumping.
- Pumping of flush water from filtered water storage tank to all terrace tanks. Maintaining records of water pumping.
- Pumping of water from filtered water storage tank to all terrace gardening water tanks. Maintaining records of water pumping.
- Pumping of domestic water to 200 lph RO water plant at terrace. maintaining water level records.
- Checking of all water lines (internal & external) relating to HMW&SB, domestic, flushing, gardening, bore water, fire fighting and RO water lines against leakage .
- Checking of water supply fittings, fixtures in labs and toilets.
- Checking of drain pipe lines in labs and toilets against choking.

 - b) Owner's Liability Act
 - c) Workmen's Compensation Act

 - e) Apprentices Act 1961
 - f) Any other Act or enactment relating thereto and rules framed thereunder from time to time.
- v. The successful tenderer shall keep all mandatory records like PF, ESI, Bonus etc. of his employees deployed at TIFR, FReTB, Survey No. 36/P, Gopanpally(Village), Serilingampally Mandal, RR Dist, Hyderabad-500107 as per requirement of the labour enforcement inspector from time to time.
- vi. The successful tenderer shall take necessary license from the Asst. Labour Commissioner and comply with the central Labour Act of 1970.

vii. The successful tenderer shall have to take necessary insurance coverage for his workmen and keep TIFR-Hyderabad indemnified against risk. Copy of such insurance premium receipt shall be submitted to TIFR-Hyderabad before the release of first payment.

2. Accidents:
