

Bid Corrigendum

Following terms and conditions supersede all existing "Buyer added Bid Specific Terms and conditions" given in the bid document or any previous corrigendum. Prospective bidders are advised to bid as per following Terms and Conditions:

Buyer Added Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions

1. **OPTION CLAUSE:** The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.
2. Scope of supply (Bid price to include all cost components) : Supply Installation Testing and Commissioning of Goods
3. Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

The Bidder should provide the compliance of below points on the letterhead duly signed and sealed with the supporting documents in the technical bid:

1. The bidder/OEM should have at least one supercomputer listed in the latest Indian Super computer list maintained by CDAC, India.

2. Bidder should be either an Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) or should be authorized System Integrator Partner having back to back Support Agreement with the OEM. Manufacturer's Authorization Form (MAF) for participating in this tender is mandatory for bidders and should be attached along with technical bids. The Bidder participating in the tender process should give the MAF confirming the bidder's authorization to participate in the tender with tender number and details.

3. The Bidder/OEM should have a service center with L1/L2 engineers stationed at Hyderabad in the relevant field of quoted item.

4. Benchmarking – As a part of commissioning, the bidders should run HPL linpack benchmark and achieve minimum 8.2 TF and also use user provided gromacs code and provide satisfactory output performances.

5. Data sheets with make and model of all quoted items should be provided with technical bid.

6. Bidder should submit the compliance sheet for all specification parameters for the quote

d items with technical bid.

7. Hard drive capacity - 2X960GB enterprise SATA SSD configured in RAID 1 for OS and 4 x 16 TB configured in RAID 5 for data.

8. RAM Capacity - Minimum 512 GB DDR5 ECC RAM

9. Form factor - 2U rackmount server with rackmount kit and peripherals.

10. Clock speed - 2.25 GHz

11. HDD and SSD capacities mentioned in the tender should be there for each server.

12. Minimum 1 GB 8 Port RAID card supporting RAID levels 0,1,5,6 and 10 or better should be provided.

Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. If any clause(s) is / are incorporated by the Buyer regarding following, the bid and resultant contracts shall be treated as null and void and such bids may be cancelled by GeM at any stage of bidding process without any notice:-

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for [attached categories](#), trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)

9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
