### Terms & Conditions:

- 1) **Bid Validity Period:** Quotations must be valid for a period of 180 days from the date of opening the bid prescribed by the Purchaser. A bid valid for a shorter period may be rejected by the Purchaser as nonresponsive.
- 2) **Delivery Location:** Community Empowerment Lab 5/9, Vineet Khand, Gomti Nagar, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh 226010.
- 3) **Delivery Period:** Need to be specified by the supplier in their bid.
- 4) **Warranty Period:** Need to be specified by the supplier in their bid; shall commence from the date of receipt of the material at the project site.
- 5) **Penalty:**
  - 5.1. The Supplier shall arrange to ship the ordered materials within the mutually agreed delivery period mentioned in the order unless extended with/without penalty. Please mention the Delivery Period Clearly in the bid, however effort to be taken to deliver the materials at the earliest.
  - 5.2. In case of delay in supply on part of the supplier, a penalty @0.5% per week of order value will be charged for delayed period subject to a maximum of 5% order value.
  - 5.3. If the delay in the shipment of the ordered materials attributable to the supplier exceeds agreed time period from the date of original agreed upon date of shipment and extended with/without penalty, the TIFR Hyderabad shall have the right to cancel the purchase order and recover the liquidated damages from other dues of the party or by legal means.   - 5.4. The same rate of penalty shall be applicable for late installation of the equipment / instrument also.
- 6) **Payment Term:** 100% payment shall be released after the receipt of complete material as per the purchase order in a single lot, successful installation and acceptance of the equipment certified by TIFR Hyderabad.
- 7) **Requirement from Bidders:**
  - 7.1.
