- 2) **Delivery Period:** Need to be specified by the supplier in their bid.
- 3) **Warranty Period:** Shall commence from the date of receipt of the material at the project site.
- 4) **Penalty:**
  - 4.1. The Supplier shall arrange to ship the ordered materials within the mutually agreed delivery period mentioned in the order unless extended with/without penalty. Please mention the Delivery Period Clearly in the bid, however effort to be taken to deliver the materials at the earliest.
